ENR NY Announces Region's 2011 Best Projects Winners

Maryland's Intercounty Connector Takes the Top Prize

New York, NY – September 21, 2011 – [ENR New York](#) today announced the winners of the New York region's Best Projects awards program. The annual competition honors construction and design excellence from across the region.

An independent jury of industry experts judged 98 nominated projects this year and selected 27 as award winners. The judges considered criteria including challenges, safety, design, innovation, quality and craftsmanship. Eligible projects were located in New York, New Jersey, New England, and parts of the Mid-Atlantic region.

The entries were judged by project type, with each category having one Best Project award winner and some categories also given one or more Award of Merit. The judges also selected the region's best project as the best of all the entries. This year's overall winner was given to the team that designed and built Intercounty Connector, Contract A, of Montgomery County, MD.

The winners, listed below, will be featured in the November issue of ENR New York and honored at an awards breakfast on November 8. The event will be held from 8 a.m. until 11 a.m. at McGraw-Hill headquarters at 1221 Avenue of the Americas, New York City.
